Its as if I went to sleep 400 hundred odd years ago and suddenly awoke as a "Nigger." In my minds eye I can see ships, but can't quite grasp the significance of their appearance, nor why there are only people of darker complexion exiting the ships bowels draped in waist chains and leg shackles. There are men, women, and children in abundance then it sound-ed as if some form of action was taking place because all I could hear was numbers, measurements, and an assort-ment of confusing tasks being hurled to and Fro.

The crowds were yelling some word that I couldn't quite understand and it frustrated me to no end.

Out of everything that was spoken, among every sound reverberating the term that stood out most in my mind was the name "Nigger".

I couldn't grasp why this name was only used to de-scribe those who were draped in waist chains, shackles, and other trinkets designed to hinder and restrict move-ment. Upon closer examination I saw that other than the hue of skin pigmentation nothing distinguished these people from the various others in attendance.

Yet, standing tall and proud among the others shack-les and chains was a much darker complexioned male of about 22 years in age who looked as if he descended from royalty. His height appeared to be about 6'5 and his weight seemed to top at 275 with bulging muscles that contracted and moved in every

shimmering cue-ball that looked like it was polished to perfection. The heavyset white man in the big white hat theatrically walked over to the huge black man then began groping his manhood and advertised the demensions as if he was describing beef at a butcher shop.

It has been said that even after hundreds of years since slavery, that those of more recent generations of Black Americans, can still feel

the ripple effects of that old peculiar institu- tion from which we first became labeled as a Nigger.

Racist whites over time have referred to Black Americans as coons, monkeys, and so many other derogatory things. I'm pretty sure most Black Americans know of these words or have heard them all. Again, over time, it began to change the way Black Americans viewed themselves. I believe that once this began to sink in, it basically changed the way we not only looked deep within ourselves, but our entire race. We have had countless spiritual, educational, political, business, entertainment, athletic, scientific and historically gifted Black American lead-ers who came to resurrect the mentally dead and psy-chologically deprived black man and women from the clutches of ignorance, so why haven't we all awakenedand obtained cultural awareness?

A Nigger, I once thought, was the figment of a racist imagination. I've often believed as much until I became conscious of the actions of a few. Not only on racist platforms that currently exist but; primarily within the in- ner-confines and boundaries of Black American ethno- cultural societal metrics: the Nigger stigma really doesexist and the resulting negative force has

become the piv-otal turning point in our existence as a people. It matters not whether you call me a monkey or donkey; it matters not what my physical attributes are for I can never lit- erally be a monkey nor donkey because it's not human- ly possible to become such. So this provokes me to en-quire on what exactly is it that makes the black man and woman a Nigger in context and thought? No one can seem to give me an explanation that makes sense enough to justify the labeling so it has become a question I have wrestled with since the rebirth of my consciousness.

You can ask a hundred different people for the answer to this most pressing question and its guaranteed that you will receive a hundred different interpretations. But, there is one thing almost all one hundred will agree on, that is the perceived color of a Nigger. This color, will in almost all cases, always undoubtedly be black or dark complexioned. The entire physical manifestation is that of a Black man or Black woman. Am I lying?

The black race specifically and in particular are a race of Niggers according to the racist white mans, his-panic mans, asian mans, arab mans and corresponding woman's viewpoint. But what has made this become our own perceptive-reality? It is to the point that even we as

a race of people have bought into the negativity and propaganda of it all.

In the book, The Fall of America by the Honorable Elijah Muhammad it states:

Who do Black Americans and the Black Race as a whole blame for their succumbing to those manufactured struggles? Race-based and control-based manufactured-struggles have plagued mankind since the begin- ning of time and have been perpetrated by those of allcolors upon one another. I cannot identify

and put into context all of the efforts of one man to instill his will over another by unscrupulous means throughout recorded history and/or history we may not even be aware of however; as it relates to Black American culture degradation. But this doesn't give us a justification, using internal Black American cultural behavior guidelines and interpretations of a Nigger amongst blacks, for acting like a Nigger. Everything about a Nigger, whether perceived or interpreted, histor- ically and culturally denotes negativity and chaos. There is a large number of our people who take great pride inbeing labeled such.

A Black American, in my opinion, should absolutely take no pride in such a derogatory and offensive term. In 2022, as Black Americans, we are still continuing to seek an identity that remains inconsistent with our existence as a race and as Americans. What I have come to realize personally during my own struggles and lessons as a black man is that my interpretation of a Nigger is someone whom lacks knowledge of self and is a social-savage, an uncivilized being who's only interest is in sowing discord among righteous people. Their actions and deeds are never in accordance with the words he or she speaks. Therefore, he or she, is not to be trusted withanything.

In my most humble opinion, based on my cultural and personal belief, a Nigger's original birthplace is in America. Furthermore, America is the only place on the face of the earth where only a Blackman or Black Woman is called a Nigger for no other real reason other than the hue of his or her complexion. To give further ar- gument to my theory, black people are not the only cul- ture of people whom have racial misfits amongst its pop- ulation of people. If we're going to solely address this ti- tle by actions and deeds,

then there will emerge others whom have exhibited the same behaviors as the so-called Nigger of dark complexion. So is a Nigger's existence based solely on color, or can it be implied through one's various actions? Why is there so much emphasis on this one particular word, phrase and or title? Can we base all the foundations of this label on racist white people's feel-ing of race- superiority or black-inferiority?

Where is the tangible evidence to support the theory of a Nigger deriving only and solely from the portals of the black race? If Marcus Garvey, Malcom X, and so many others addressing the black race, can be guilty of preaching hatred towards the white man, then I ask you what makes so many racist white religious and politi- cal leaders any less guilty? Biblical history speaks that whenever a people had went astray from God's desires, aprophet or warner was sent to lead the people back along the righteous path. When you make mention of all the prophets of biblical legend, they were all unlearned men who held no formal education and emerged from among the worse in terms of morality and principled behaviors. These prophets were instructed and taught to spread the enlightenment amongst their own tribes, clans, culture. What we have

learned from teachings would become widespread. So is it logical that we should label these men and women of God racist because they initially were instructed to awaken those among their people primarily?

Why is it than that prophets and messengers of later generations, whom happen to have been of the black race, are labeled haters of Caucasians simply because they were trying to restore racial pride in their own people?

A Nigger is real yet; culturally he doesn't actually ex- ist however; you still have those of the Caucasian persua- sion constantly imitating the behaviors and mannerisms of the very people whom some of which claim to hate so much. It could be said it is an oxymoron for some to express hate for a race of people and still have those that seek the vibrant cultural aspects of the race that truly do exist; to become the mirror image of everything associat-ed and contributed to such a people in terms of accom-plishments overall. White slave masters, through trick- ery and deceit, have totally white washed history to an extent never before done by any other race of people and they are still not

satisfied with their devious shenanigans against one of God's creation. Where does the treachery end and true equality begin?

And every nation has a term so when its term comes, they cannot remain behind the least while nor can they precede it (The Holy Quran / Surah 7 ayat 34).

Now, taking into context our second definition of what constitutes a "Nigger", we find that anyone or any dark-skinned people could be a "Nigger". The same applies to any member of a class of people that are socially, economically, or politically deprived. So, why is it that the black man and black woman in America solely fill this demographic? Are we the only class of people that are from the end for which the needle points? There are many nationalities of people who are in fact socially, economically, and politically deprived so the world over is filled with "Niggers" if we look at it from the various na-tionality perspective. Now let's look at things from the behavioral perspective. Are dark skinned Black, African or even Hispanics solely "Niggers"? If so, what other ev- idence do you have to support your arguments beside those within the pages of American Published dictionar- ies? Because if skin-color is all you have, then you could very well be a "Nigger" too!

Could you please explain to me what exactly is

the outcome you're seeking when members of your race (The White) frequent the various tanning salons throughout the planet? Why are white women with big butts a cur-rent phenomenon?
